

LONG ISLAND PLASTIC SURGICAL GROUP CHIEF RESIDENTS SELECTED FOR PRESENTATION AT NY REGIONAL SOCIETY OF PLASTIC SURGEONS

March 10, 2006 - Garden City, NY. On Monday, March 6, 2006 New York Regional Society of Plastic Surgeons held its annual resident presentation competition. Forty scientific papers from residents in the metropolitan area and Connecticut were submitted, but only twelve were selected for presentation at this prestigious meeting. Two of the three chief residents from The Nassau University Medical Center's program had their work accepted for presentation. This program is directed by doctors from Long Island Plastic Surgical Group (LIPSG).

Dr. Dimitri Koumanis presented a paper (co-authored by B. Greenberg) entitled "Controlled Study of Fibrin Sealants in Abdominoplasty". This paper received the second prize in the overall competition. Dr. Julie Vasile presented her senior work (co-authored by R. Simpson, F. Katzman, and G. Pillersdorf) entitled "The Lower Lip in Facial Paralysis: An Algorithm for Treatment".
